REV. DR. R. H. GAGE, CHURCH LEADER, DEAD

Former Moderator of New Jersey Presbyterian Synod—Pastor for 37 Years in Wenonah, N. J.

WENONAH, N. J., Dec. 19.—The Rev. Dr. Raymond Hilliard Gage, 62 years old, for the last thirty-seven years pastor of the Wenonah Memorial Presbyterian Church, died here tonight at his home after a long illness.

At the time of his death, Dr. Gage was moderator of the West Jersey Presbytery and chairman of the New Jersey Synodical Committee of the Presbyterian Church. He was also a former moderator of the New Jersey Presbyterian Synod and was a delegate to several general assemblies of his denomination.

Dr. Gage was graduated from Yale in 1891 and from Princeton Theological Seminary in 1894. Lafayette College awarded him the honorary degree of Doctor of Divinity in 1922.

Two sons, Raymond and James Gage, both of Philadelphia, survive. Dr. Gage's funeral will be held on Thursday afternoon at 2 o'clock in the Wenonah Presbyterian Church.
