

Wenonah Swim Club Will Open Pool on May 30

Construction of the pools and facilities for the Wenonah Swimming Club are rapidly nearing completion, according to James W. Savin, president of the club.

Underwater lighting equipment has been installed and the white porcelain finish is ready for application in the main pool. The entire pool and grounds area are now fenced in; grading on the tennis courts is complete, and ready for the hard-surface finish, Andy Wesh and Jack Sheppard, who are on the building committee, report.

Carl Gottschling and John McQuaide, of the personnel committee, have secured the services of Samuel Porch, Jr., of Glassboro, as pool manager, and Woody Woods, also of Glassboro, as life guard captain. Life guards and help at the pool have been interviewed and readied for opening date, which is set for May 30.

Jo Park and Norm Sanger, of the program committee, have things well lined up for the season, with many water sports and swimming events planned.

Trustees and officers of the pool are Jim Savin, Andy Wesh, Jack Sheppard, Tony Sacca, Harvey Cale, Carl Gottschling, Jo Park, Norm Sanger, John McQuaide and Ted Worthington. These men, whose occupations are varied, have worked hard and long at making the pool and its facilities the best in the South Jersey area, with meetings being held at least once each week.
