

Wenonah Man Gets Pure Water Patent

Wenonah, Aug. 7—A United States patent was recently granted to Churchill Hungerford Jr., of Wenonah, and R. G. Weston, of Philadelphia, covering the purification of water.

This equipment will be primarily used in a projected program for treating water to the high degree of purity that is required in atomic power installations.

Modification of this water purification equipment will make it available for general use in industrial plants and municipal installations.
